Our company will file and track copyright applications, file the necessary performance rights information as well as maintain a liaison with each performance rights society. We will negotiate and issue all licenses, and collect, calculate and distribute royalty income. We have the capabilities to perform these services domestically and in foreign territories.

FTM is not interested in acquiring ownership in song catalogs. Our only goal is to make the music publisher more productive by removing the administrative "burden." In addition, for select catalogs, we will work to secure alternative sources of income for the catalog.
